

## The Prince's Trust Education Offer – for young people aged 11 to 25



### **Achieve/Achieve for Younger Learners**

Achieve is a Personal Development Programme which aims to increase attendance, attainment, and soft skills such as confidence and teamworking skills. The offer promotes a flexible approach, using experiential learning to support achievement in a range of different areas. Young people will gain the Prince's Trust Personal Development and Employability Qualification, which sits on the SCQF at levels 3, 4 and 5. It is also benchmarked on Insight

Consists key themes:

- Life Skills
- Personal Social Development
- Active Citizenship
- Enterprise
- Prep for World of Work
- Achieve Enrichment – Apple STEM activities, Volunteer workshops, World of work tours and School Transition Events

All resources, training and support is offered by the Prince's Trust. The programme is mainly delivered by School teaching staff or DYW co-ordinators. The Programme is flexible but generally runs 3 periods a week over any Education or Youth Work setting.

### **Enterprise Challenge**

Inter School competition delivered by Volunteers, available Scotland Wide throughout the academic year. It involves pupils taking part in an online business simulation game, preparing pitches, and creating a social enterprise. Winning Schools from the first phase go onto the Scotland final to present their Social Enterprise idea with a £1000 prize pot for the winning team. This is delivered in partnership with Apple.

### **LEAP**

4-week part-time School transition programme delivered in collaboration with Prince's Trust Staff and Prince's Trust Volunteers, with six days of partner-led themed employability sessions and training. Includes one to ones and sector qualifications.

### **Mosaic\***

Mentoring Programme for Young People from any underrepresented background. Focus on Young People from ethnic minorities, young woman and care experienced Young People. 7 Mentoring sessions over a flexible time period. Mentors are trained by PT and from diverse backgrounds. Includes World of Work tour and inspirational speakers.
