Masterclasses

Our masterclasses are aimed at students aged 11 to 18. Masterclasses are closely linked to the curriculum and feature exciting hands-on learning opportunities.



Careers Conferences

Our senior camps are aimed at a post-16 audience, while our junior camps are aimed at 10- to 13-year-olds.
