

The STEM Nation Award was designed by Education Scotland, taking inspiration from the Scottish Government's STEM education and training strategy (2017), to celebrate, promote and build on effective practice in STEM education within and across sectors.

The STEM nation award is comprised of five elements which link with the key priorities from the STEM education and training strategy. The five elements are:

- Leadership in STEM
- STEM family and community learning
- Employability and STEM partnership working
- STEM curriculum pathways/progression routes
- Equity and equality in STEM
