Excellerators Programme: Remote Work Experience

The Slaughter and May Excellerators Programme is a remote work experience designed to offer students an insight into working at an international law firm - from lawyers to business services, including legal technology, business development and responsible business. Students across the UK will develop essential employability skills through interactive workshops, activities and networking sessions online.

The programme features four placements across the year (May, July and October 2026), giving students a chance to develop their skills and knowledge over time.

Application criteria:

- Be in Year 12 (England & Wales), S5 (Scotland) or 13 (Northern Ireland) at school.
- Be attending a state-funded, non-fee paying school.

Meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Have been, or are currently, in local authority care.
- Are currently in receipt of, or have previously received, free school meals, Pupil Premium, Education Maintenance Allowance and/or 16 to 19 Bursary.
- Are, or have been, a full-time or part-time carer.
- Came to the UK as a refugee or asylum seeker.
- Live in a household where the occupation of the main household earner is categorised as a routine or manual occupation
- Grew up in a household where no parent or guardian attended University.

Apply by 3rd April 2026

Students need to attend all of these Programme dates:

- 28th May
- 27-30th July
- 26th October
